

## CT Total Abdomen or Renal Stone Without Contrast

APPOINTMENT	- DATE: TIME: Please arrive 15 minutes before your appointment time and check in at the registration desk.
HOW LONG THE EXAM WILL TAKE	- The exam will take approximately 10 minutes
HOW TO PREPARE FOR THE EXAM	<ul> <li>Do not eat solid foods 4 hours before the exam</li> <li>You may take medications as prescribed.</li> <li>You may be asked to drink a liquid containing contrast when you arrive</li> </ul>
PRECAUTIONS YOU SHOULD BE AWARE OF	<ul> <li>If you think you may be pregnant or if you are breast feeding, please notify your physician or the technologist prior to your exam.</li> <li>If you are allergic to Iodine notify your technologist.</li> </ul>
WHAT YOU CAN EXPECT	<ul> <li>The exam will consist of lying on a bed that moves through a scanner.</li> <li>You will be asked to lie still during the exam and you may be asked to hold your breath for a short period of time.</li> <li>Please feel free to ask the technologist any questions you may have before the beginning of the exam.</li> </ul>
HOW DO YOU GET TEST RESULTS?	- A Radiologist will study the images and a report will be sent to your physician, after which they will discuss the results with you. Should you not hear from your physician within 2 business days, please give them a call to schedule a follow up appointment.
