

Nuclear Medicine Gastric Emptying

APPOINTMENT	- DATE: TIME: Please arrive 15 minutes before your appointment time and check in at the registration desk.
HOW LONG THE EXAM WILL TAKE	- The exam will take approximately 2 hours
HOW TO PREPARE FOR THE EXAM	 Do not eat or drink after midnight. If you are diabetic, bring your insulin with you but do not take it before the exam. Although some medications affect how your stomach digests, you do not need to discontinue them unless your doctor tells you otherwise.
PRECAUTIONS YOU SHOULD BE AWARE OF	- If you think you may be pregnant or if you are breast feeding, please notify your physician or the technologist prior to your exam.
WHAT YOU CAN EXPECT	 You will be fed 2 scrambled eggs and then you will be imaged for the next 90 minutes to 2 hours. Some patients may receive an injection after 90 minutes of images.
HOW DO YOU GET TEST RESULTS?	- A Radiologist will study the images and a report will be sent to your physician. This normally takes 2 business days. Your physician will discuss the results with you. Should you not hear from your physician within 2 business days, please give them a call to schedule a follow up appointment.
