

## Nuclear Medicine Renal Scan

APPOINTMENT	- DATE: TIME: Please arrive 15 minutes before your appointment time and check in at the registration desk.
HOW LONG THE EXAM WILL TAKE	- The exam will take approximately 1 hour.
HOW TO PREPARE FOR THE EXAM	<ul> <li>There is no special preparation for having a Renal Scan other than drinking plenty of fluids before the exam.</li> <li>If you are doing this exam to evaluate high blood pressure, you may be asked to discontinue your blood pressure medicine for 7 days prior to the exam.</li> </ul>
PRECAUTIONS YOU SHOULD BE AWARE OF	- If you think you may be pregnant or if you are breast feeding, please notify your physician or the technologist prior to your exam.
WHAT YOU CAN EXPECT	<ul> <li>You will be given an injection and images will be taken for 30 minutes.</li> <li>In some cases, imaging may take a total of 90 minutes.</li> </ul>
HOW DO YOU GET TEST RESULTS?	- A Radiologist will study the images and a report will be sent to your physician. This normally takes 2 business days. Your physician will discuss the results with you. Should you not hear from your physician within 2 business days, please give them a call to schedule a follow up appointment.
