

Diagnostic X-Ray Small Bowel Series

APPOINTMENT	- DATE: TIME: Please arrive 15 minutes before your appointment time and check in at the registration desk.
HOW LONG THE EXAM WILL TAKE	- The exam will take approximately 1 to 2 hours
HOW TO PREPARE FOR THE EXAM	 Do not eat or drink after midnight. You may take your morning medications with a small amount of water. You may be asked to take a bowel cleansing preparation solution the night before Wear comfortable clothing free of metal (zippers, buttons, etc) You may wish to bring reading materials
PRECAUTIONS YOU SHOULD BE AWARE OF	- If you think you may be pregnant or if you are breast feeding, please notify your physician or the technologist prior to your exam.
WHAT YOU CAN EXPECT	 This exam usually follows an Upper Gastro Intestinal Series For this exam, you will be asked to drink some barium and you may be asked to take some granules that cause air in your stomach and intestines. Several x-rays will be taken of you drinking barium and laying in different positions. Upon completion of the exam drink plenty of water.
HOW DO YOU GET TEST RESULTS?	- A Radiologist will study the images and a report will be sent to your physician, after which they will discuss the results with you. Should you not hear from your physician within 2 business days, please give them a call to schedule a follow up appointment.
