HOW LONG THE EXAM WILL TAKE	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - The exam will take approximately 10 minutes
HOW TO PREPARE FOR THE EXAM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Do not eat solid foods 4 hours before the exam - You may take medications as prescribed. - You may be asked to drink a liquid containing contrast when you arrive
PRECAUTIONS YOU SHOULD BE AWARE OF	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - If you think you may be pregnant or if you are breast feeding, please notify your physician or the technologist prior to your exam. - If you are allergic to Iodine notify your technologist.
WHAT YOU CAN EXPECT	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - The exam will consist of lying on a bed that moves through a scanner. - You will be asked to lie still during the exam and you may be asked to hold your breath for a short period of time. - Please feel free to ask the technologist any questions you may have before the beginning of the exam.
HOW DO YOU GET TEST RESULTS?	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - A Radiologist will study the images and a report will be sent to your physician, after which they will discuss the results with you. Should you not hear from your physician within 2 business days, please give them a call to schedule a follow up appointment.
