HOW LONG THE EXAM WILL TAKE	<p>- The exam will take approximately 1 hour.</p>
HOW TO PREPARE FOR THE EXAM	<p>- There is no special preparation for having a MUGA Scan.</p>
PRECAUTIONS YOU SHOULD BE AWARE OF	<p>- If you think you may be pregnant or if you are breast feeding, please notify your physician or the technologist prior to your exam.</p>
WHAT YOU CAN EXPECT	<ul style="list-style-type: none">- You will have your blood drawn and it will be re-injected into you after being made radioactive.- Imaging takes approximately 30 minutes.
HOW DO YOU GET TEST RESULTS?	<p>- A Radiologist will study the images and a report will be sent to your physician. This normally takes 2 business days. Your physician will discuss the results with you. Should you not hear from your physician within 2 business days, please give them a call to schedule a follow up appointment.</p>
